1. There is a proposition for a multi-million pound revamp of the town centre
2. The SLC local plan proposes 9000 new houses, 2500 of which would be built in East Kilbride. However, that proposition has still to complete a planning stage and be adjudicated on by an independent reporter appointed by the Scottish Executive.
3. On the expansion of the site near Lidl, there is prospect of a pharmacy being built and he will be pressing for the expansion of other medical services, in particular a GP's surgery for the area.
